



## Service Certificate


Mr Aragorn-Oliver Sackmann, born on 10 July 1979 in Berlin, completed his basic military service in the German Armed Forces (Bundeswehr) from 1 November 2000 to 31 August 2001.

After successfully completing the two-month basic military training from November to December 2000 at an Air Force training regiment, he was subsequently deployed after a further two-month on-the-job training period (AAP) as an air defense missile soldier (PATRIOT) with a PATRIOT air defense missile battery of the German Air Force.

As a PATRIOT air defense missile soldier, he was qualified to operate and monitor launch sites of the PATRIOT weapons system as well as to handle specialized surveillance equipment. His duties and responsibilities included geographical positioning of launch units, operation of gyroscopic systems, preparation of launch equipment for deployment, operation of communication systems, technical inspection and maintenance, execution of prescribed maintenance tasks, basic functional checks, and the elimination of minor technical malfunctions.
